*New skid road cuts Pasture Path at Tilton Spring.*



*Another skid road cuts Pasture Path, just past Tilton Spring. The road splits and leads to clear cuts just visible through the trees, at the top of the photo, right and left.*

*In logged areas remaining trees are elegant with the colors of fall.*





*The skid roads and strip cuts form an elaborate network. Here two meet in a mixed section of forest. Note the many young trees.*



*The NEFF land abuts the WMNF. This wye junction was cut in a coniferous grove near the National Forest Wilderness boundary.*



*This clear cut goes almost up to the Sandwich Range Wilderness boundary. In fact, the WMNF property boundary sign is faintly visible near the center of this photo.*

*The Wilderness boundary stake, which is not visible, is right next to the yellow property boundary sign, because in this area the Wilderness boundary is the National Forest boundary.*



*The only buffer protecting this section of the Sandwich Range Wilderness was these NEFF lands, now shorn.*
